

# **AQUA**

## **DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS**

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

#### **GENERAL**

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

### **AQUA**

- Chrome-tanned cow hides, aniline through dyed.
- The top surface is nude leather with no surface coating or protection.

## **CARE INSTRUCTIONS**

- This leather can quickly soil on upholstery. A suitable aniline cleaning product can be used to maintain this leather.
- Any spillage will sink into this leather and create a permanent stain.
- Using in very high-traffic areas is not recommended because of high maintenance.
