

ARIZONA

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

ARIZONA

- European cow, average hide size will be five sqm. Chrome-tanned aniline through dyed, corrected grain distressed wax finish.
- The leather shows some healed scratches neck, and belly wrinkles, which will be apparent because of the naked finish.
- The use of wax in the finishing makes this leather feel natural and has a distressed effect.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Aniline leathers are generally delicate, so strong cleaning products should not be used.
- Alma suggests using the recommended Aniline cleaner once every week, which will keep the
 leather clean and fresh; the Leather clinic Moisturiser will keep the floor hydrated and maintain the
 moisture content of the leather, which is essential for the life of the leather.
