

CALF

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

CALF

- English calf, thickness 2-2.0mm, Average hide size will be 2.5 sqm. Chrome-tanned aniline through dyed, corrected grain smooth look.
- The leather is treated with a solid protection coat to make it suitable for flooring.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Regular cleaning with the leather cleaner and lubricating with the moisturizer is advised.
