DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

IMPERIAL

- European cow, whole grain, natural tumbled, aniline-dyed polished leather.
- The polished topcoat gives luster and depth to the color.
- It is an aniline leather; therefore, the surface has no protection coat.
- Being aniline leather, the leather shows natural scars and marks, and during aging, it develops a
 patina, which adds character and looks.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Aniline leathers are sensitive to heat, abrasion, spillages, or other accidents.
- For cleaning, you should use a specific aniline cleaner that will not do any harm to the finish and the grain surface, and always pre-test before applying any cleaning agents
- Any spillages should be blotted immediately with an absorbent dry cloth. Do not rub.
