

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

OLIVA

- Olive-leaf tanned and aniline-finished cowhides.
- This leather creates a patina with wear and can be polished with wax to regain the luster.
- Any scratches can be removed with wax and soft, dry cloth polishing. On handling, the leather is worn off beautifully, and the color may be darker, which keeps the look and luster timeless.
- Avoid ant wet cleaning. It is susceptible to heat, so please do not dry fast if the leather is damp. Natural drying and polishing with a dry cloth will return the luster.
