



PONY

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

PONY

- These leathers are natural hides and hair; please do not use solvent-based cleaning products.
- Brush with a soft brush to remove any dirt, and please brush the hair in the direction of the hair.
- For wet cleaning, use a soft, damp cloth; if necessary, use mild soap and water. Dry with a smooth, dry cloth. Please do not soak the leather while cleaning.
- This leather must be used with the utmost care not to stain it. Please avoid using any alcohol or any other solvents for cleaning.
- The hair is natural and is subject to natural wear and tear.
- It is always recommended to test a small area in a corner to see how the skin reacts with any cleaning.
