



SHAGREEN

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use standard household cleaning products, as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

SHAGREEN

- Real stingray fish skins tanned in a unique way suitable for home interior use and finished in a natural method of buffing and polishing.
- It is a drum-dyed aniline leather with no protective coating. Dry vacuum the skins or air blast to remove dust or deposits.
- These skins are porous, so any stains will pass through the substrate and be challenging to remove. In case of spillage, wipe off immediately and dry the skin with a hair dryer.
