

WOVEN

DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Leather is a natural product – each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a patina.

GENERAL

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather.
- Avoid direct heat onto the leather.
- Avoid placing the leather next to a heat source.
- Dust and vacuum regularly to avoid a build-up of dust; if vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately with a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth, taking care not to soak the leather.
- Avoid being near any leather with any pen or ink.
- Do not use everyday household cleaning products as these may react with the finish, causing cracking.
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather.

WOVEN

- Real Woven leathers are made from aniline leather and vegetable-tanned leather.
- Vacuum the leather with a soft brush to avoid dust accumulation between the weave threads.
- Any spillage should be wiped off immediately to avoid permanent staining; no wet cleaning is recommended. Polishing the leather with a dry cloth may keep the luster look.
