# LEATHER DESCRIPTION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

## General Care Instructions

Leather is a natural product. Each hide is unique and carries the natural characteristics of its origin, which will vary from hide to hide. As leather ages, it matures and develops a beautiful patina over time.

## General Care Guidelines

- Avoid direct sunlight on the leather
- Avoid direct heat exposure
- Do not place leather next to a heat source
- Dust and vacuum regularly to prevent the build-up of dust. If vacuuming, use a soft head attachment
- Wipe off stains and spills immediately using a clean, soft, lightly damp cloth. Do not soak the leather
- Keep leather away from pens or any ink to prevent permanent marks
- Do not use normal household cleaning products, as they may react with the finish and cause cracking
- Do not use saddle soap or shoe polish on the leather

## Storm Leather

- Cow shoulder vegetable tanned skins
- Finished with oil and polyurethane

Storm leather develops a rich patina with wear. It can be polished with wax to restore its natural lustre.

Minor scratches can be reduced or removed by gently polishing with wax and a soft dry cloth. With handling, the leather wears beautifully, and the colour may darken slightly over time, enhancing its timeless character and depth.

## Important Care Notes for Storm Leather

- Avoid any wet cleaning
- This leather is very sensitive to heat
- If the leather becomes wet, do not dry it quickly
- Allow it to dry naturally
- Once dry, polish gently with a soft dry cloth to restore lustre
